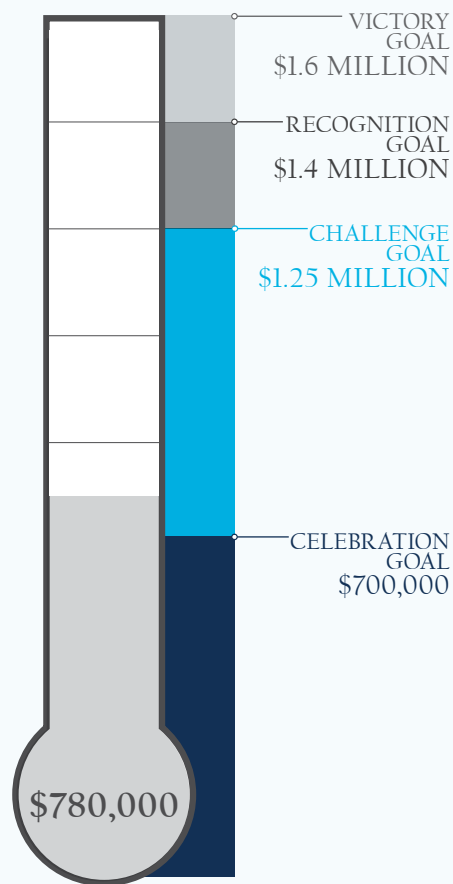
CAPITAL CAMPAIGN NEWS

We wish to offer a sincere thank you to those who made a commitment to the *Honoring Our Past...Preserving Our Future* Capital Campaign. More than 140 families have committed more than \$780,000 in gifts and pledges toward our campaign goal. Your generosity allowed us to realize our \$700,000 *Celebration Goal*. While we are grateful for this response and proud of those who defined their sacrificial commitment, this represents only 18 percent of our faith family. We must continue working to reach the \$1.25 million *Challenge Goal*.
